**FACTS**--SC ranks 18th for gun deaths in the US. Since 2010, the rate of gun deaths in SC has risen 42%, while national rise is 17%! Guns are now the leading cause of deaths for children in SC (about 78/yr).

Yet our state legislators keep proposing crazy bills that make it easier to get guns by: taking away back-ground checks, taking away safety permitting, and lowering the legal age from 21 to 18 to purchase firearms.


